Pitching: once again is a strength, as we have depth here, if a teammate isn't able to find their feel for the pitch they have support from several arms that are looking for an opportunity to earn a starting spot or 1st up reliever. Currently the starters are Bennett, Saul Johnson (Jr) and Smidt.
